This user's guide describes XYZ Lightbox Pop's Graphical User Interface (GUI). It shows you how to use each menu item in the GUI.

## Introduction

Congratulations for using XYZ Lightbox Pop! Lightbox Pop gives you the ability to create lightbox with custom content in your site. You can configure lightbox position settings (height, width ,top, left) in percentage or pixels, display logic related settings (time delay after page load, number of pages to browse for lightbox to appear, lightbox repeat interval for a user) and style settings(z-index, overlay opacity, color, border etc). You can use the lightbox to display any type of contents such as special promotions, subscription forms, social media icons, video presentations and much more.

## Getting Started

The steps in this section will show you how to set up the lightbox in your website.

The free version contains only 2 pages in admin area.

- A. Settings
- B. About

The public side is the lightbox and the overlay. Overlay is the background of the lightbox. We can change the position, width, height, color etc. of the lightbox from the admin area.

The admin sections are given below.

### Lightbox Content

We can add the content of the lightbox here.

We can add text, image, subscription form, video, audio, shortcodes from other plugins etc. in the content box.

We are using the Wordpress default HTML editor in the lightbox Pop plugin and so you can see the visual as well as the HTML formats of the content.

### Lightbox Position Settings

Here we can set the position of the lightbox in your webpages.

We can set the top and left coordinates of the lightbox pop and width and height of the lightbox.

We can use the percentage (%) and pixel (px) formats for the position settings.

Lightbox top coordinate – This represents the position of the lightbox from the top of the window

Lightbox left coordinate – This represents the position of the lightbox from the left of the window

Lightbox width – This is the width of the lightbox

Lightbox height – This is the height of the lightbox

### Lightbox Display Logic Settings

This section allows us to select the lightbox display logic.

We can display the lightbox based on delay, number of pages browsed or both.

Lightbox display logic – This is the logic how to display the lightbox in our webpages.

There are 3 options.

1. Based on delay
2. Based on number of pages browsed
3. both

In the “Based on delay” logic, the lightbox will appear after a delay. You can set this delay.

In the “Based on number of pages browsed” logic, the lightbox will appear after the user browsing some pages.

In the “both” option, the lightbox will appear after a particular delay and after the user browsed some pages.

Delay in seconds before lightbox appears – This is the delay for showing the lightbox. This value is applicable only if the Lightbox display logic is based on delay and both.

Number of pages to browse before lightbox appears – This setting is applicable only if we selected the display logic 'Based on the webpages browsed or both'. We can set the no. of webpages and the lightbox appear only after the user browses that much pages.

Lightbox repeat interval for a user – This is the lightbox repeat interval. If you want to display the lightbox again after 30 minutes, you can enter that value here.

Lightbox close button option – You can display the close button with the lightbox if you are selecting the 'yes' option. If you are selected the option 'No', we can close the lightbox by clicking on any position in overlay.

Display as iframe – We can display the lightbox in iframe or in the same page.

If you are using the iframe, any link in the lightbox or buttons will open in the same lightbox.

To open a link in a window outside the lightbox or to use a social media button, please disable the iframe display.

### **Lightbox Placement Settings**

Placement mechanism – This is the mechanism we are using to add the lightbox in pages.

There are 2 place mechanisms

1. Automatic – Here the Light box will load in all pages.
2. Manual – If you want to display the lightbox in particular pages, use this option. Now you need to add the short code `[xyz_lbx_default_code]` in the pages where you want to display the lightbox.

### **Lightbox Style Settings**

Here we can select the style of the lightbox

Lightbox z index – Z index determines whether the lightbox display bottom or top of other page contents. As the value of z index increases, the lightbox become on top of all page contents.

Lightbox overlay opacity(0-100) – This is the opacity level of the overlay. If the value of opacity is '0', the overlay should be a transparent one. If the value is '100', the overlay should be opaque.

Lightbox overlay color – We can set the overlay color here using a color picker.

Lightbox background color – We can select the lightbox background using a color picker.

Lightbox border color – This is the color of the lightbox border.

Lightbox border width – We can set the width/thickness of the lightbox border here.

Lightbox border radius – If you want a rounded corner for the lightbox, use this option. As the radius increases, the roundness also increases. Use '0' for rectangular edges.

Reset cookies?(for testing) – For testing purposes we need to reset the cookies. Tick this option to reset the cookies.

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

### 1. The Lightbox Pop is not working properly

Please check the wordpress version you are using. Make sure it meets the minimum version recommended by us. Make sure all files of the 'lightbox pop' plugin uploaded to the folder 'wp-content/plugins/'

### 2. Can I use this plugin with other lightbox plugins ?

It may interfere with each other if there are 2 or more lightbox plugins.

### 3. Can I add my own styles for the overlay ?

Yes, you can change the style of the overlay from the settings page. You can use an image for the overlay in the premium version.

### 4. Can I set lightbox repeat interval in minutes ?

Yes, this option is available from the Lightbox Pop version 1.1 onwards.

### 5. What kind of contents can be placed in lightbox ?

You may use the lightbox to display any type of contents such as special promotions, subscription forms, social media icons, video presentations and much more.

### 6. Can I display lightboxes in specific pages only ?

Yes, you can do this in the lightbox pop plugin. For the use the option Placement mechanism as manual and add the short code `[xyz_lbx_default_code]` in the pages.

### 7. Can I create multiple lightboxes for different pages ?

Yes, you need to purchase the premium version for this feature.

### 8. When I add a link in the lightbox, it is opening in the same lightbox. How can I open the link outside the lightbox?

There are 2 methods to open the link outside the lightbox.

- a) Disable the iframe settings in the settings page. That is select 'Display as iframe' to "NO"
- b) While adding a link, use the value `target="_blank"` with the `<a href >`tag.

For example, `<a href="http://xyzscripts.com" target="_blank">XYZScripts</a>`

**9. The close button is laying under the video that is used in the lightbox. How can I move the close button above the video?**

This is because of the property of the video you are using. To solve this issue, please use the value `wmode=transparent` with the video source.

For example, the embed code of a youtube video is like

```
<iframe width="600" height="375" src="http://www.youtube.com/embed/abcd12345?rel=0&autoplay=1" frameborder="0" allowfullscreen></iframe>
```

Please change it to

```
<iframe width="600" height="375" src="http://www.youtube.com/embed/abcd12345?rel=0&autoplay=1&wmode=transparent" frameborder="0" allowfullscreen></iframe>
```

**10. Can I display the contents from another plugin using a shortcode in lightbox?**

Yes, this is possible in the lightbox pop v 1.1 onwards.
