A) About Slippy Slider

Slippy Slider is a cross-device jQuery content slider with amazing touch-based navigation and simple user-friendly backend. It will help you create an amazing presentation on your website.

B) Requirements

Requires: 2.0.2 or higher Wordpress installation **Compatible up to:** 3.4.2 - tested

C) Installation & Setup

Setting up Slippy Slider is easy, just follow these instructions:

1. Download Slippy Slider .zip file
2. In the Wordpress back-end go in Plugins > Add New (<http://site.com/wp-admin/plugin-install.php>) and Select Upload
3. Upload and activate the plugin
4. Go in Slippy Slider menu item

5. Delete the template Sliders and add new ones.
6. Paste the shortocde in some of your pages/posts or the PHP code in your theme files

D) Updating Slippy Slider

E) How to Use

Open the Slippy Slider admin panel. You can see there the View, Add and Info Menu items.

First delete the sample sliders and click on Add in the menu. Fill in the following required fields:

- Slider name
- Width & height
- Upload image for first slider

Additional option is the Autoplay field. To enable this option for that particular slider, set it to more than 0 seconds.

This will rotate your slides, and pause the rotation when you hovering over the slider.

F) Shortcodes

To display any slider in your page or post you can use the following Wordpress shortcode in brackets:

```
[slippy-slider slider="My Slider" ]
```

That will include a slider with the default size. To modify the height or width you can use the "s_height" and "s_width" attributes:

```
[slippy-slider slider="My Slider" s_width="1024px" s_height="300px" ]
```

If you enter a percentage in the width field, it will stretch the slider to any sort of environment.
