




## Create Facebook App Instructions


1. Go to <https://developers.facebook.com/apps> and click the “Add a New App” button.




2. Enter a Display Name, your contact email.


3. Click the "Create App ID" then fill in the Security Check captcha and click submit.




9. Paste it in the Plugin Settings Page, and then click Save Settings.
